PlaqueOff Animal study, dogs and cats 2007-2008

- Performed by Annalena Sörensson, Varbergsveterinärerna (Varberg Veterinary Clinic).
- In total, 9 dogs and 1 cat accomplished the study.
- Results already after 2 month.

Reduction of dental calculus Reduction of bad breath

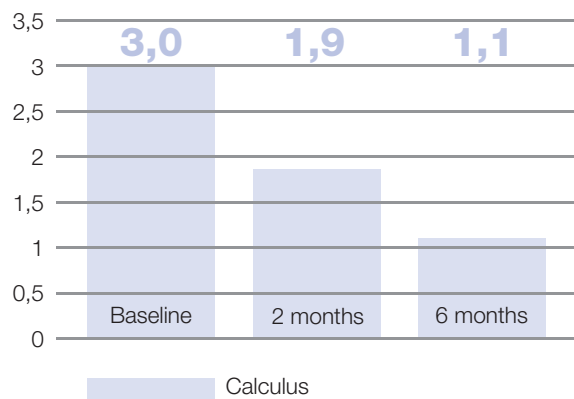
- After 2 months four dog owners were recommended to increase the dosage by 50-100%
- After 4 months the hardness of the remaining dental calculus was measured.
- The remaining dental calculus was in all animals very soft and easy to remove.

Dental calculus

Fig.1. The amount of dental calculus was judged by the veterinarian at baseline and after 2, 4 and 6 months.

Calculus Breath

3 = not good, 2 = better, 1 = much better, 0 = excellent



Measurement

A scale from 0 to 3 was used to describe baseline status and changes during the study

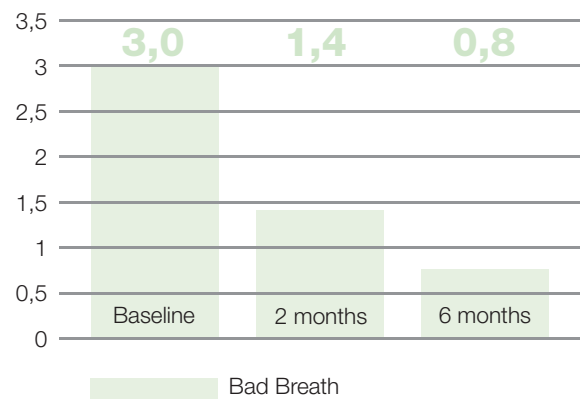
Scale: 3 = not good, 2 = better, 1 = much better, 0 = excellent.

Fig.2. The degree of bad breath was judged both by the animal owner and the veterinarian.
